Simulation-Based Patient Safety Course 2011

The Simulation-based Patient Safety Course (SPS Course) is a new course intended to enhanced communication and other teamwork skills to maximise patient safety and outcome. The course focuses on communication, mutual support, situation monitoring and leadership. Participants are immersed in interactive learning activities including simulated clinical scenarios followed by a debriefing. The SPS Course is adapted from TeamSTEPPS programme of the DoD & AHRQ in US. Come have some fun & learn at the same time!

At the end of the course, the participants will be able to:

- work more effectively as a team
- use effective communication techniques
- recognize factors affecting team performance
- take up a leadership role when appropriate
