The Team-based Simulation Patient Safety course focuses on aspects of teamwork in clinical management to improve patient safety and outcome. The course focuses on team dynamics, communication, situation monitoring and leadership. Participants are immersed in interactive activities including simulated clinical scenarios followed by a debriefing. The Course is adapted from the TeamSTEPPS programme of the Department of Defense USA. Come join us!

- work more effectively as a team
- use effective communication techniques
- recognize factors affecting team performance
- take up a leadership role when appropriate
