# **Safe Sedation Nursing Course 2014-15**

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Identify the roles and responsibilities of each sedation team member
- Understand the principles, process & safety aspects of sedation procedure
- Utilize update knowledge and demonstrate care for the patient during pre-procedure assessment, intra-procedure monitoring and post-sedation recovery and discharge
- Outline the routes, dosages & recognize the adverse effects of drugs used in sedation
- Conduct continuous monitor & recognize the various depths of sedation, client's level of consciousness & response to verbal commands, the cardio-respiratory status & other physiological parameters
- Identify potential complication of procedural sedation and apply nursing intervention to ensure client safety
- Demonstrate immediate life support skills and initiate immediate life support measures promptly during sedation procedure.
