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# Verification of Accuracy of HKCA Trainee e-logbook Entries

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#### **Objective**

To verify that an anaesthesia trainee had anaesthetized those cases he / she recorded in the HKCA e-log book.

#### **Scope**

All currently registered HKCA trainees at or beyond the third year of vocational training.

#### **Frequency**

To be conducted yearly at least.

The Board of Education shall review the need for more frequent verifications.

## **Method**

- 1. For each exercise, the College Office will randomly select approximately 10-15% of all currently registered HKCA trainees at or beyond the third year of training.
- 2. For each selected trainee, the College Office will randomly select a set of 20 cases, done within the previous 2 years of training, from the SOT-approved list. Cases of acute pain service and chronic pain consultation will be excluded.
- 3. For each selected case, <u>the trainee</u> will need to submit affirmative evidence that he / she had anaesthetized the case under supervision. This means a copy of the anaesthesia record with the trainee's name recorded as (one of) the attending anaesthetist(s).
- 4. Should the trainee fail to provide the above, explanation must be given by the trainee to prove beyond reasonable doubt that he / she had anaesthetized the case. Supportive evidence may include, but not limited to
  - A printed elective list with the name of the trainee as one of the duty anaesthetists,
  - A duty roster indicating that the trainee was rostered to anaesthetize the case,
  - A certification letter stating the attendance of the trainee during the case, signed by the specialist anaesthetist in charge of the case, or the Supervisor of Training (or his/her Deputy) of the hospital where the case was anaesthetized.
- 5. The selected trainee must submit <u>printed hard copies</u> of the above evidence for all selected cases <u>within 2 months of notice</u>. For cases done in hospitals other than the current hospital where the trainee is working, assistance from the Supervisor of Training may be sought. With the exception of the <u>hospital number</u> as the case identifier, other patient identifiers (HKID and Name of patient) should be deleted before submission to the College.
- 6. Failure to provide affirmative evidence for <u>3 (or more) cases</u> within the set of 20 selected cases would be considered unsatisfactory verification. If a satisfactory

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written explanation cannot be offered for failure to provide affirmative evidence in any one of the 3 (or more) cases, the trainee will be required to repeat the audit using a second set of 20 randomly selected cases on the SOT-approved list. Failure to provide affirmative evidence again for <u>3 (or more) cases</u> within the second set would be considered unsatisfactory verification.

## **Actions**

If a trainee failed two sets of verifications, the Board of Education and/or the HKCA Council will decide on subsequent actions. These may include one or more of , but not limited to, the following action(s):

- 1. Requiring the trainee to submit affirmative evidences for all cases that has been logged in;
- 2. Formal warning to the trainee;
- 3. Extension of training period;
- 4. Termination of training;
- 5. Exclusion from exit assessment;
- 6. Reporting to the Medical Council of Hong Kong.
