- 1. Describe the features of the anaesthetic machine which are intended to prevent delivery of a hypoxic mixture to the patient.
- 2. How would you assess and prepare a 6 week old male infant for surgical correction of pyloric stenosis?
- 3. Describe the features of phantom limb pain and outline its management,
- 4. A 65 year old female presents with a fractured neck of femur after a fall. She is recently diagnosed to have a ortic stenosis with recent echocardiography showing a valve area of 0.8 sq cm. She has no angina or syncopy. Her exercise tolerance is limited by severe osteoarthritis. Outline your anaesthetic management.
- 5. Describe the anaesthetic considerations for posterior spinal fusion in idiopathic thoracic scoliosis.
- 6. Discuss the use of combined spinal epidural anaesthesia as a regional anaesthetic technique for Caesarean Section.
- Discuss how you would prevent post-operative delirium in an elderly patient after repair of hip fracture.
- 8. Discuss the use of laryngeal mask airway (both classic and ProSeal<sup>TM</sup>) for controlled ventilation
- 9. Describe the strategies that can be used to reduce the occurrence of awareness under general anaesthesia.
