QUESTION ONE

A 35 year old female with known asthma is admitted to your ICU from accident and emergency because of her deteriorating clinical state.

- (1) What clinical indicators tell you that she has severe asthma?
- (2) Describe in detail your management plan over the first 24 hours in the unit.

Despite your therapy, she continues to deteriorate. You decide she requires intubation.

(3) Please describe in detail your method of intubation and mode of ventilation and what complications may occur from doing so.

After a week in the unit, her bronchospasm has cleared. Despite that, she is becoming difficult to wean off the ventilator.

(4) Describe your approach to this problem.

QUESTION TWO

- (1) Discuss your clinical indications for the insertion of a pulmonary artery flotation catheter (PAFC).
- (2) Describe the factors affecting pulmonary artery catheter data interpretation.
- (3) Summarise the recent literature regarding the relationship between PAFC use and clinical outcome, and your interpretation of these findings.
- (4) Describe what factors you regard as important in the evaluation of a sophisticated hemodynamic monitoring system?
- (5) Describe other technologies which are available to monitor hemodynamic parameters and their place in your clinical management.

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
