QUESTION ONE

Discuss what injuries you expect in this patient.

Discuss the management of this patient in the first 24 hours.

QUESTION TWO

A 60 year old man with peritonitis from a perforated colonic diverticulum develops septic shock, disseminated intravascular coagulation, and acute renal failure.

1. Discuss your indications for renal replacement therapy. What is meant by the term 'blood purification'?

The patient is commenced on CVVH.

- 2. Discuss your anticoagulation strategy for CVVH in this patient.
- 3. How would you decide on the replacement fluid anion for this patient?
