ANSWER THE FOLLOWING

- 1. Describe the causes of hypoxaemia in ICU patients.
- 2. List the causes of diarrhea in ICU patients, and describe how you would diagnose the cause in a particular patient.
- 3. Describe the clinical presentation of a patient with 'thyroid storm' and list the causes and differential diagnoses.
- 4. A patient you are caring for in a peripheral hospital has a cervical spine fracture with tetraplegia from a diving accident. Describe your preparation to escort this patient to a larger hospital via ambulance.
- 5. Describe the clinical presentation and acute management of severe paracetamol poisoning.
- 6. A 40 year old female was admitted to a general ward with vomiting and vague chest pain. She has a witnessed cardiac arrest, and the initial ECG rhythm is a sinus tachycardia of 130/min. Describe your resuscitation and acute investigation of the cause of this arrest with pulseless electrical activity.

- 7. Describe the post-operative complications of oesophagectomy.
- 8. What do you believe to be the indications for therapeutic hypothermia in ICU? What are the various means to achieve hypothermia in ICU?
- 9. What antibiotics may be used to treat methicillin resistant *Staph aureus* (MRSA), and what are their side-effects?
- 10. Define acute coronary syndrome (ACS) and describe the diagnosis of ACS in ICU?
- 11. What are the risk factors for acute renal impairment due to radiological contrast and what could be done to ameliorate this risk?
- 12. You are called to resuscitate a patient with newly diagnosed pre-eclampsia who is now suffering grand mal seizures. Describe your acute management.
- 13. Write a brief explanation of brain death for publication in a newspaper. It should be 3-4 paragraphs long, factually correct, but able to be understood by a layman.
- 14. List and briefly describe antifungal agents that may be used in the treatment of *Aspergillus* infections.
- 15. Describe briefly the treatment of acute variceal haemorrhage.
