 - 4. A 75 year old lady was referred to you for persistent pain at the site of L2 vertebral collapse secondary to osteoporosis. Outline your management for this patient.
 - 5. Discuss the effect of gender on pain experience.
 - 6. What is pseudo-addiction? How would you make this diagnosis in a 32 year old opioid tolerant woman complaining of severe pain following a diagnostic laparoscopy?
 - 7. Discuss the mechanisms of action and roles of serotonin noradrenaline reuptake inhibitors (SNRI) in pain management.
 - 8. Outline the key points of radiation safety during interventional procedures for pain management.
