



Guidelines on Reinstatement of Fellowship of the Hong Kong College of Anaesthesiologists

The following guidelines apply to reinstatement applications by ex-Fellows of the Hong Kong College of Anaesthesiologists (HKCA) who was terminated under M&A clause 5.1.2(2) (in arrears of payment of subscription).

I. Requirements for Reinstatement

Reinstatement of Fellowship of HKCA shall be:

- a. at the discretion of the Council,
- b. upon payment of fees as determined by the HKCA from time to time, and
- c. subject to additional conditions other than those listed in (a) and (b) if Council thinks it necessary.

II. Fees Payable upon Application for Reinstatement

Notes:

- a. Resignation must be in written form.
- b. Any subscriptions/fees due and unsettled before removal or notice of resignation will be regarded as outstanding subscriptions/fees.

III. Reinstatement Procedures

- a. When an application for reinstatement is received, the application will be circulated to the Board of Censors for consideration. The Board's recommendation will then be put to the Council for endorsement after the applicant has settled all fees required according to the prevailing policy (see II above).
