Question 1

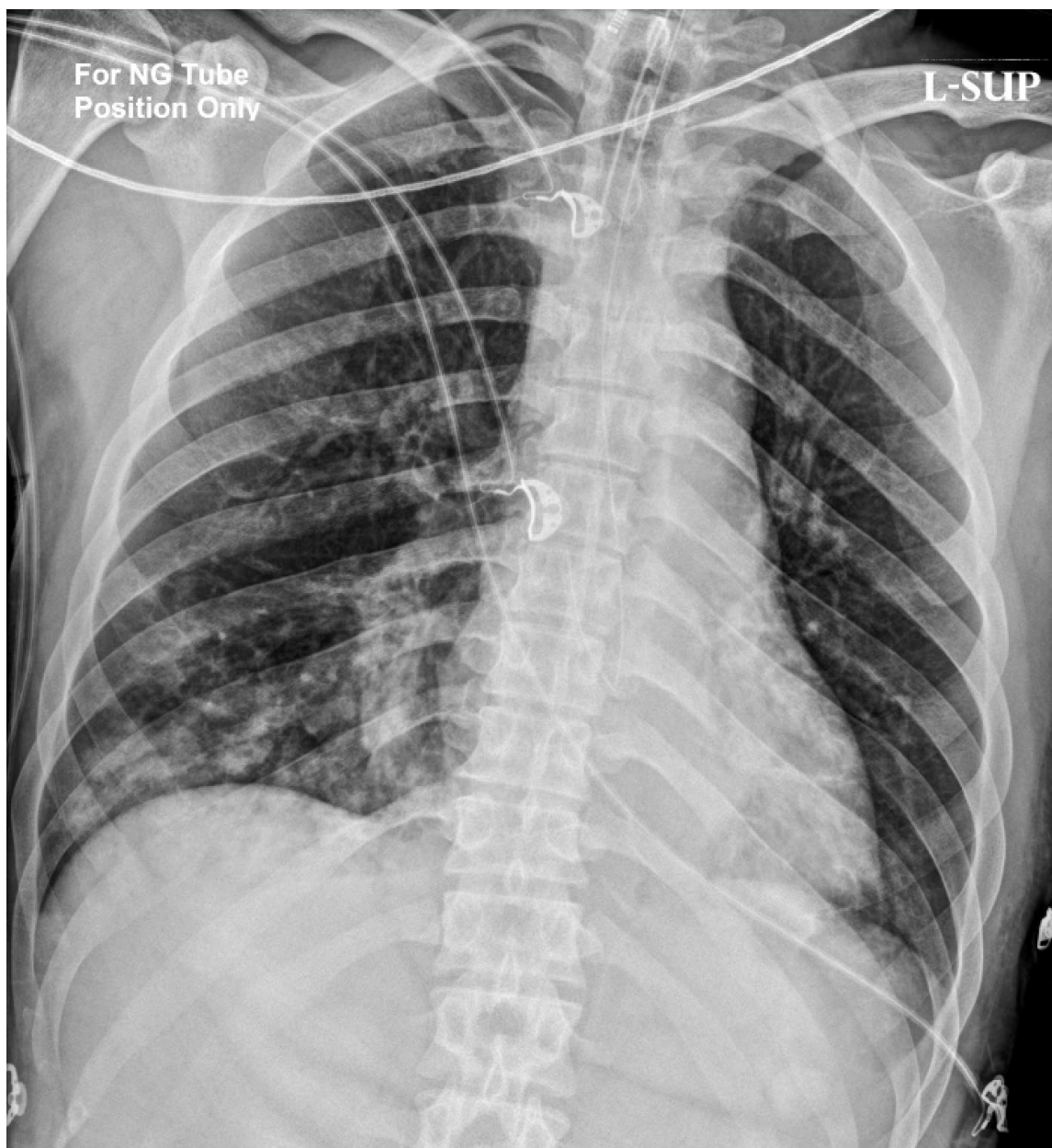


A 62-year-old male chronic smoker is scheduled for elective laparoscopic cholecystectomy. This is his preoperative chest X-ray.

Question 2

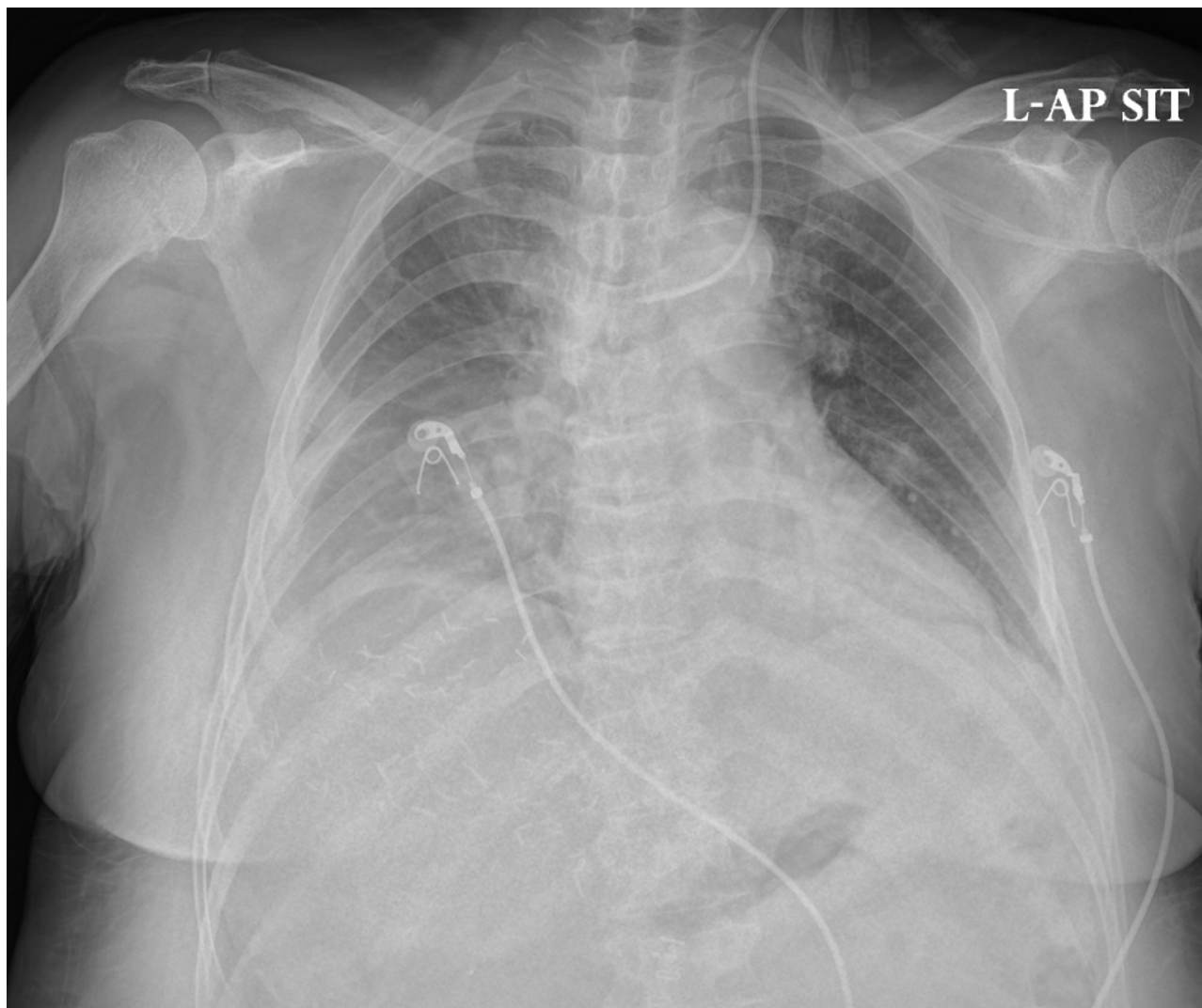


A 32-year-old male admitted with fever and persistent vomiting is scheduled for OGD under MAC in 5 days. This is his preoperative chest X-ray.

Question 3



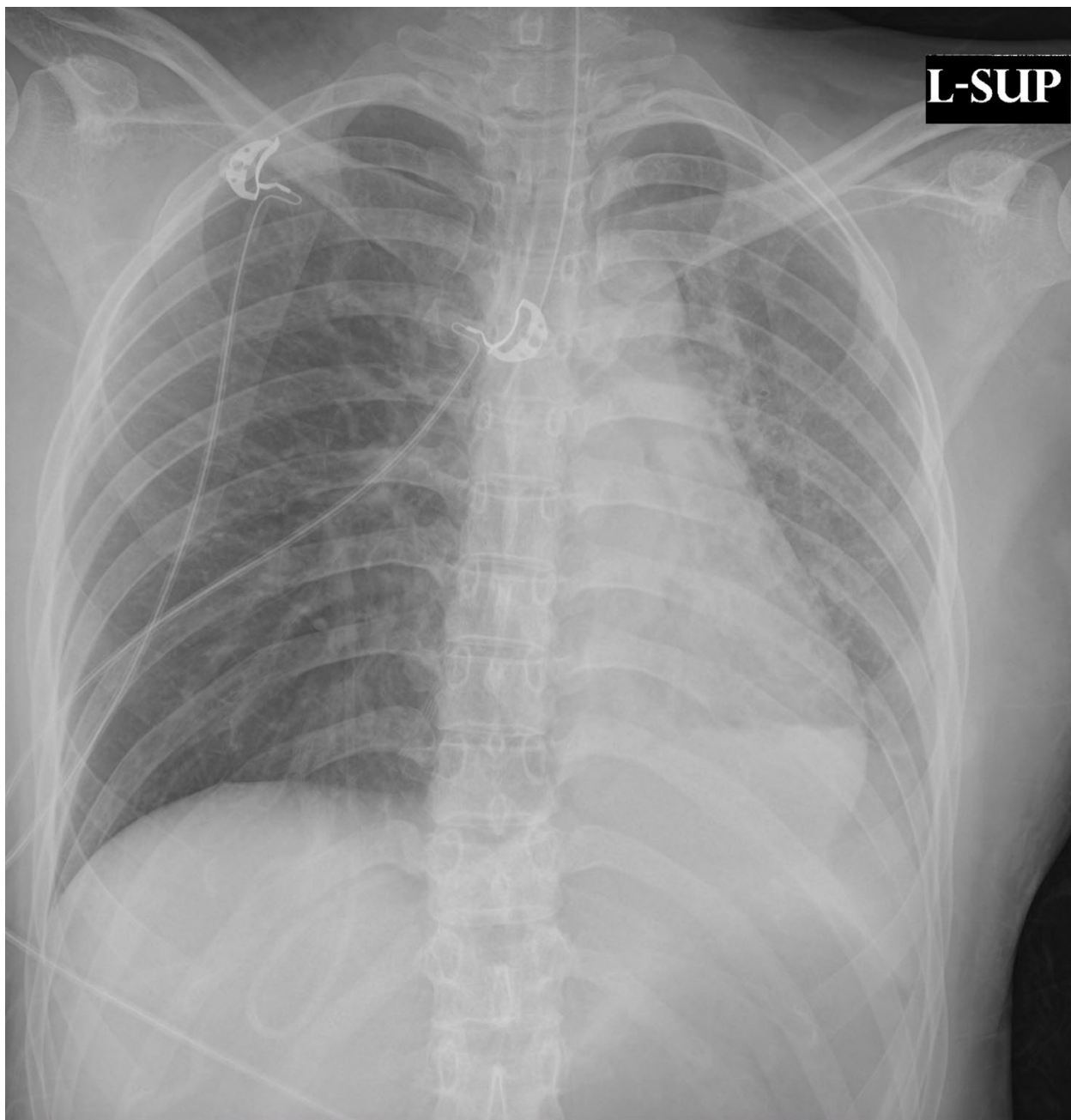
A 62-year-old female has just undergone a right hepatectomy. This chest X-ray was taken in the PACU to check central venous catheter position.

Question 4

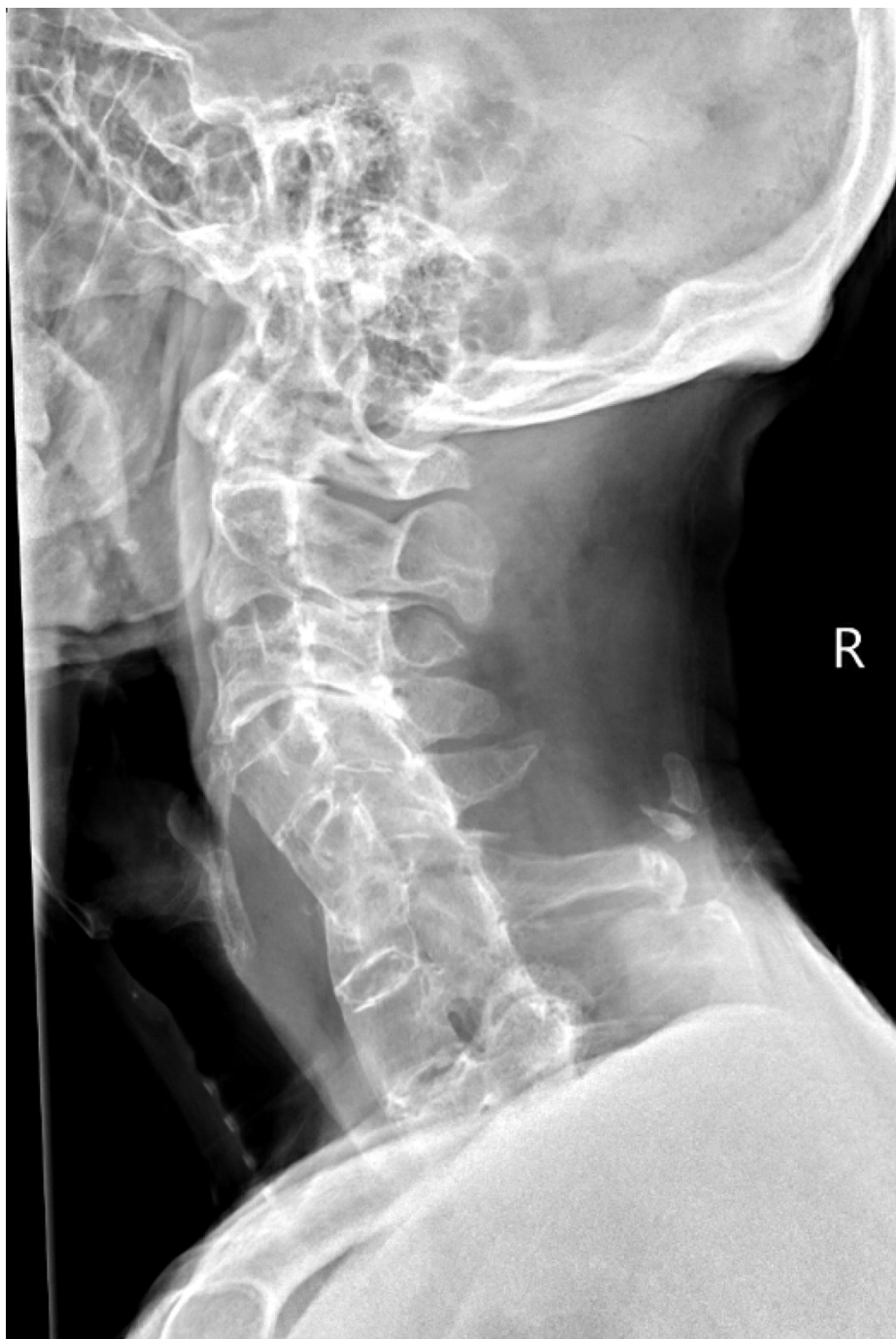


A 31-year-old female is admitted to the ICU after emergency LSCS under general anaesthesia. This is her ICU chest X-ray.
